The 34-story building, by developer Euro Towers, is near business centers, eco-parks, restaurants, wellness

centers, and other key destinations.

To get a feel of the life at Milan Residenze Fairview, model units are available to visit at Euro Tower's showroom at Quirino Highway, cor. Maligaya Drive in Fairview. Home seekers can take a look at the display units' unique features via installed monitor screens that give a glimpse to the amenities and facilities of the vertical community.

Daily activities can be performed with ease in the studio and onebedroom units with soundproof and thermal walls that also give a sense of privacy and reduced heat flow.

All units, ranging from 22 sqm to 50 sqm in size, come furnished with a balcony, along with soft-closing kitchen cabinets, a lightweight panel wall, as well as a provision for kitchen exhaust piping out to the balcony, and a washing machine.

Bali-inspired clubhouse opens at South Forbes

Driving through the south side of South Forbes Golf City's Nirwana Bali village, one comes across an Asianstyle roofed pavilion surrounded by tall palm trees and tropical plants. The structure, simple but inviting, leads to the new clubhouse.

At the bottom of the stairs, two big pavilions, a turquoise pool and three small, private cabanas for gatherings greet you. Throughout, tropical landscaping accented by flowers and shrubs lend a tropical resort feel

The architectural design also minimized earth movement, thus preserving much of the original terrain. Not only that, the landscaper - Atty. Ronald Uy, legal head of Cathay Land also preserved an old native tree that borders the clubhouse's cliff edge. This private retreat is an exclusive amenity for residents of South Forbes Golf City's Nirwana Bali.
